MASTER GARDENER CLASS FOR FIFTH GRADE

NMES has partnered with Miami County Purdue Extension Master Gardeners to provide a Junior Master Gardener program to our fifth grade students called Learn, Grow, Eat, Go. Local master gardeners are coming to the school twice a week for five weeks and working with our students to help them better understand plants and how they provide for people's needs. The unit teaches students the process of establishing a thriving garden that is easy to create and maintain. They provide opportunities for fresh vegetable tasting/evaluation, simple recipe demos, and physical activities that research shows can improve on-task behavior and academic performance. Our plan is to expand Purdue Extension programming to more grade levels in the following year.



READ-A-THON FUNDRAISER

Thank you for supporting our students in our read-a-thon fundraiser. Our goal was to raise \$8500 and read 85,000 minutes. We exceeded our goal! We raised \$9110, and the students read 151, minutes!
