School Safety Update

We are always looking to ensure our school is as safe as possible. One way is using a program called "Safe Visitor" that logs when we have guests in our building. Typically, when a visitor comes for a field trip or a meeting, we have them sign in on a sheet. We will be expanding the use of the Safe Visitor program and begin scanning every person who enters the building so we have a digital log as well. **To gain entry into the office we will ask to scan your drivers license or the barcode that was sent to you when you completed your volunteer background check.** Thank you for helping us add one more layer of security to our school!

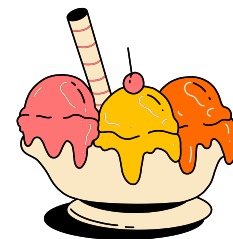
\$10 - Chocolate Syrup

Happy Birthday to You!

Birthdays in elementary school are VERY important and should be celebrated! One way that we know students celebrate is by bringing invitations to school for a party. To ensure that feelings are not hurt, our school policy is that if you are bringing birthday invitations to school, please be sure you have one for every homeroom class member. If you aren't planning on inviting everyone, we ask you make arrangements for the party outside of school hours. Below is the birthday treat and invitation policy from our school handbook.

Student Birthdays

Birthdays and celebrations must be arranged with the classroom teacher. Student birthdays can be celebrated with store-bought pre-packaged treats. Due to concerns for students with food allergies or restrictions, we ask that all treats are store-bought.

- Birthday invitations can be distributed to the entire class. It must go to all students in the homeroom class. We do not distribute to any other classes or grade levels.

Your classroom teacher will be able to give you specifics concerning the party he/she will be having in the room. Students will be allowed to dress as their favorite storybook character that day.
