Open House: August 7th from 4:30 - 6:00

Open house will be on Monday, August 7th from 4:30 - 6:00pm. Come visit your classroom, meet your teacher, see your friends and have some ice cream! Reporting Absences and End of Day Changes

Please be sure to report your child's *absence no later than 9:00am*. At that point, the office begins calling any parent whose child has not been called in for the day. The attendance hotline is available 24 hours a day, so please call and leave a message as soon as you know your child will not attend school for the day.

If you have an end of day dismissal change, call the school no later than 2:30. This will give us time to get the change information to the teacher and the student before 3:00 when dismissal begins.

Students Attending School Sporting Events

Students who attend school sporting events can get in for free again this year when they are accompanied by a paying adult. Students who attend games alone will be charged full admission price. To ensure they have a responsible adult in case of an emergency, no student fifth grade or younger should be dropped off at a sporting event alone.

NMES STEAM

What is STEAM? We are glad you asked! STEAM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics. NMES offers many STEAM programs, such as:

- Honeywell Artist in Residence Program: Honeywell Educational Outreach will be bringing various artists into the school to work with students. Artists will work in different mediums, such as opera, songwriting, and storytelling through both song and oration.
- PLTW LAUNCH NMES is a Project Lead the Way school. PLTW focuses on three major areas: engineering, biomedical and computer science. The elementary program is called LAUNCH. It is an interactive curriculum where students not only learn content but are asked to apply their knowledge by solving real-world programs in a hands-on way.
- Fine Arts School Programs: We host fine arts nights for each grade level throughout the year. Each fine arts night includes a music program and an art gallery where you can view the art that students have created.
